

Lankaran State University is a member of the following international associations:

### **Black Sea Association**

The Black Sea Association is an international organization that promotes cooperation between universities of countries located in the Black Sea region. Being a member of this association, Lankaran State University implements joint projects in the field of education and culture with the countries of the region, conducts research and organizes student exchange programs. This membership allows the university to establish stronger educational relations in the Black Sea region and further strengthen its position at the international level.

In 1996, the Association of Universities of the Caspian Littoral States was established at the initiative of the Astrakhan State Technical University of Russia, the Gorgan University of Agricultural Sciences and the Ministry of Natural Resources of Iran. This Association includes universities and research institutes of the Caspian Basin countries.

Lankaran State University has also been elected a member of this Association. The membership of the Association is constantly expanding. Currently, the members of the Association constitute more than 50 universities and research institutes.
