Academic Programs

Undergraduate Programs:

Research and Sustainability Initiatives

- Climate Action Plan: Development of strategies to reduce greenhouse gas emissions and promote sustainable development.

 International Projects: Participation in initiatives like the REFRESH project, focusing on renewable energy sources and climate change mitigation.



Additionally, LSU has signed bilateral cooperation agreements with the Ministry of Ecology and Natural Resources, Hirkan National Park, and Kyzylagac National Park, facilitating joint scientific research and participation in environmental events.



Community Engagement and Events

LSU actively engages with the community through various environmental events:

- Flamingo Festival: Held at Kyzylagac National Park, LSU students participated and won first place in an environmental knowledge competition.l
- International Conferences: LSU hosted a conference on "Protection of Biological Diversity and Ecologically Sustainable Socio-Economic Development," with participation from representatives of 10 foreign countries.
- **Seminars**: Topics such as "Ecological Factors and Climate Change" have been explored in joint seminars with other institutions.

The "Biology and Ecology" department conducts scientific research on topics like "Biological Monitoring of Environmental Pollution in the Southern Region," providing students with practical experience in environmental monitoring.
