An event dedicated to the 530th anniversary of M. Fuzuli was held at LSU.

According to the decree of the President of the Republic of Azerbaijan Ilham Aliyev dated January 25, 2024, a literary and artistic evening dedicated to the 530th anniversary of the great Azerbaijani poet and thinker Muhammad Fuzuli was held at Lankaran State University (LDU).
