Lankaran, Astara and Lerik regions participate in the Zone Subject Olympiad. Pupils participating in the knowledge competition answer three open-type questions in 2 hours and 30 minutes on the subjects of their choice. An award ceremony is holding for the winners of the Olympiad, and they are presenting with honorary degrees, diplomas and valuable gifts of Lankaran State University. The Zone Subject Olympiad is holding at Lankaran State University every year. In the past 6 years, about 2100 students have participated in the Zone Subject Olympiad, which is traditionally holding every year.
