In the 2023-2024 academic year, students studied at Lankaran State University as their Second Higher Education. These students were accepted without the need for an entrance exam and are pursuing their previous diploma.

II higher education is carried out on the basis of specially developed educational programs, covering the general and specialized subjects sections of the basic educational programs available for the bachelor's (and equivalent) level in the relevant specialty, taking into account the difference between the basic educational program previously received by the student and the basic educational program of the new specialty.

Those wishing to receive II higher education must submit the following documents:

- application;
- a notarized copy of the document on higher education (diploma and its supplement);
- a copy of the work book; (if working)
- 6 photos measuring 3 x 4 cm;
- a copy of the identity card;
- a military ticket for boys or a copy of the military registration certificate in the Military Service;

An interview is held with those who have submitted documents to the university for receiving II higher education. Those who successfully pass the interview are accepted as students in the relevant specialties to receive II higher education on a contract basis.

Those who successfully complete their education will be awarded a state-standard Bachelor's Diploma.

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
